

Society Scavenger hunt guidance

This guidance is intended for groups & societies carrying out scavenger hunt type events.

The following measures must be followed to prevent the spread of Covid-19

1. Anybody reporting symptoms of COVID-19 will not be permitted to attend and must stay at home and self-isolate in accordance with government advice.
2. Follow the Covid code <https://www.st-andrews.ac.uk/coronavirus/covid-code/>
3. Only use easily accessible public spaces.
4. Choose outdoor space where possible.
5. Tasks should be accessed electronically
6. Tasks should be spread out as much as possible to minimise the risk of crowding
7. The time limit for the completion should be generous enough to prevent crowding.
8. If one team is at a task location when another team arrives the team arriving must wait at a safe distance for the first team to finish.
9. Proof of task completion should be electronic e.g. a photo submitted by online form
10. Participants must take part in groups of no more than 5, all from the same household/"bubble".
11. So far as is reasonably practicable, social distancing of 2 metres be maintained between participants
12. There should be no fixed starting point; teams should start at their own house/flat.
13. Face coverings will be mandatory for participants.
14. Participants must practice good hygiene & clean their hands before attending.
15. Alcohol hand sanitizer (>70%) should be carried by all participants and used frequently.
16. No music (live or recorded) is permitted.
17. No food or drink will be sold or distributed.
