### **1. Approval of last meeting's minutes**

### **3. Convenor report**

Tania reported that the PGT review is over. A 35-page report has been produced. It is currently with the Principals' office and will be passed to other committees. The outcome of the review will hopefully get more dedicated study space for taught postgraduates and twice as many rooms for postgrads next year. Tania stated that they would be able to apply to other housing as returning students.
