 - o Action Point: SPs try to finish co-opting class reps as soon as possible

- 2. Motion on in-person teaching 15 mins

(Kian Cross)

- Refer to previous meeting minutes RM (SP CompSci) on in-person teaching
- Kian Cross has written a motion for the SA to have a stance on in-person teaching
 - Kian the purpose of the motion: Transparency, communication, consistency. To have a clarified stance from the SA speaking for the students and what they would like.

- Kian hopes this will inevitably help increase the amount of in-person teaching.
- Questions/Comments with Kian:
 - *Question*: TR (SP Phys & Astro) asks how Kian would handle people who are not comfortable to be in larger lectures. TR points out that 601 is a choice whereas lectures etc. are not. *Answer/Response*: Kian responds that removing the 35-person limit will take away the one size fits all requirement. It would give the Schools more choice. Says if 601 is 'safe' then why would in-person teaching not also be safe.
 - *Response from TR*: TR states that putting people who are not comfortable with more than 35 people in a room online will create a new problem.
 - *Comment*: CM (PG Academic Convenor) says the University is aware of this issue and the 35 is not an arbitrary number. The 35 is a suggestion from the government; same goes for library bookings. This matter has been taken to the Proctor. Advice: Get in touch with the Proctor to get up to date on the government guidelines.
 - *Comment*: RM (SP CompSci) wants to make the point that the university has said that an online class is equivalent to an in-person class which is not necessarily the case. RM points out that there is an inconsistency in the School of CS.
 - *Comment*: Kian points out that at some point a transition needs to be made towards in-person teaching.
- Kian leaves the call for SP only discussion.
- Questions/Comments without Kian:
 - *Comment:* FL (SP Management) says that in schools that are smaller increasing the number might be fantastic, but for larger schools a small increase in numbers will not make a change.
 - *Question*: RB (SP International Relations) asks if there will be a vote on whether to support the motion or not. *Answer:* SPs will receive an email from Kian to sign onto the motion. SPs can sign as SP or as an individual if signed as an SP that signature would represent the entire school.
- 3. Student Diversity Officers 10 mins

(Salma Ali; English SP)

- Salma Ali from the BAME Biology Team would like to gage interest about having a diversity officer in each school.

 - Could be anything but important to have someone working towards racial justice and anti-racist change!
 - This is important because changes made from higher up tend to get diluted when coming down to the schools, so by each school having a diversity officer, there would always be someone right in the mix.
 - 7 step plan to start this is on the slides linked above.

- *Question*: SN (SP Chemistry) asks what if there are not enough people who volunteer for this role or committee. *Answer:* Salma's advice is to send out emails to gage interest or approach those you think would be good for the committee.

- A reminder of SP and LC behavior expectations
- The FPs and DoEd have noticed that some SPs and LCs have not been doing everything they need to. Not something to be guilty about, but something to be aware of.
- Email policy: Answer emails within 48 hours.
- Rules from SPs and LCs
 - SPs must come to EduCom every week. If an SP cannot, they must send apologies.
 - SPs must submit a report every week and at the end of the semester. That is not optional.
 - SPs must chair their SSCCs and attend EDI.

- *Question*: SA (SP SocAnth) asks how involved SPs should be in the separate PG SSCC. *Answer*: This has been left up to the discression of the schools.
