1. Adoption of the Agenda

3. Adoption of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

Pursuant to Standing Orders §7.2.2, the minutes of the Executive Committee meeting held on the 5th of December 2013 were laid before the members on the 7th of December 2013. With no objections registered within 24 hours, the minutes were adopted by electronic mail.

4. Matters Arising from the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

5. Unfinished General Business

There was no unfinished general business.

6. New General Business

6.1. Consideration of Reinstatements Under Association Councils Absence Policy

Without dissent, the Committee dissolved in camera.

The conditions of Mr DaBell's reinstatement were reviewed and found to have been breached; Mr DaBell's reinstatement was found to no longer be in effect.

Without dissent, the committee resolved to adjourn ex camera.

6.2. Ratification of Dixon Amendment to J. 23 on Behalf of the Students' Representative Council

Mr Dixon moved to strike all references to 'Chapter 2' in paragraph 9 through 15 and replace it with 'chapter 3'.

Mr Woodhouse seconded.

The amendment was ratified without dissent.

6.3. Ratification of Hill Amendment to J. 24 on Behalf of the Students' Representative Council

Ms Gold moved to strike 'both the SRC and the SSC' from resolving clause 1, 5.1, and replace it with 'the Association Councils'.

Mr Woodhouse seconded.

The amendment was ratified without dissent.

6.4. Ratification of Woodhouse Amendment to J. 26 on Behalf of the Students' Representative Council

Mr Woodhouse moved to insert 'and to take effect on July 1^{st'} after 'that the same do pass' in the first sentence of the resolving section.

Mr Dixon seconded.

The amendment was ratified without dissent.

Ms Lewis asked if the Committee could get a rubber stamp.

Mr Baldi ruled that the Senior Officer's remarks were out of order.

6.5. Ratification of Dixon Amendment to J. 26 on Behalf of the Students' Representative Council

Mr Dixon moved that the extant text of Article 1 in the attached constitution be struck and replaced with the following: 'The organisation shall be a subcommittee of the Student Services Council and shall be known as the Postgraduate Society of the University of St Andrews.'

Ms Hill seconded.

The amendment was ratified without dissent.

6.6. Ratification of Ekanayaka Amendment to J. 29 on Behalf of the Students' Representative Council

Ms Ekanayaka moved that '& SSC' be inserted following 'To create a non-voting member position on the SRC' in resolving clause 1.

Ms Woodhall seconded the motion.

Ms Hill explained the effect and justification of the motion to Mr Bryce.

The amendment was ratified without dissent.
