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Wide participation is being anticipated PGs who teach may also participate in strike action Importance to recognise that EduCom is part of a representation body that also encompasses PGs Further strikes have been tentatively announced for February 2023 Review of Chase's email which was sent around earlier this week Sandro adds: PGs will be supportive of strike action Motion will be proposed at SRC next week (Week 10) Motion is composed of different sections of action so that SRC has full power over what is being approved and what the Union stands behind information that Chase has put out in strikes email should be shared Motion has to be sent out by 11th November 2022 Understanding SP and LC thoughts on strike action for FPs to go into SRC next week In the following part, each section of the motion is briefly explained and a quick handsign is asked of SPs and LCs so that the Faculty Presidents can adequately represent EduCom at the SRC. SPs and LCs act as representatives, not individuals in this. A form will be sent out after EduCom for additional comments and/or if SPs and LCs do not feel comfortable speaking up at EduCom Motion sections a. Reps can actively inform their electorate b.
