- Saints LGBT+ represents LGBT+ Students to the University and in the Union
- The BAME Student Network represents students of colour to the University and in the Union
- The Disabled Students' Network represents students with disabilities to the University and in the Union
- The Gender Equality and Feminists' Network represents women and promotes gender equality to the University and in the Union

LIBERATION EQUALITY COMMUNITY INCLUSION

- The “Liberation Networks” would represent key groups with characteristics protected by law. They consist of **Saints LGBT+, the BAME Student Network, the Disabled Student Network, and the Gender Equality and Feminists Network.**
- “Representation Networks” are groups/officers that represent specific groups of students. They consist of the International Students’ Network, the Caregivers, Commuters, Mature, and Flexible Learners Student Network, the Estranged and Care-Experienced Students Network, and the Student Health Officer/Network
- Per the recent revisions to the network system, the following officers and networks now sit under the remit of the President of Union Affairs: Accommodation Officer, Community Relations Officer, Environment Officer/Network, and the Widening Access and Participation Officer
- **The Executive** (meeting once a month) would consist of the President and the four “Liberation Networks”
- All other “Representation Networks” will receive an open invite and see the agenda and minutes for each Executive meeting, but it would not be mandatory for them to come. This will also allow the President to extend invitations to other groups that wish to be involved, like Nightline and StAnd Together
