2 Minutes & Matters Arising

3 Semester Two Strategy

The Director of Education discussed proposed changes to the operations of Education Committee. Members agreed to have weekly reports submitted on the Thursday in advance of a meeting on the Monday, to allow for a more focused agenda.

4 NSS

The Director of Education informed members that the NSS will open on the 5th of February and that they should promote it in their Schools. Only final year undergraduate students are eligible to complete the survey. Some students may have issues with eligibility if they have recently made changes to their degree intentions, and School Presidents should direct them to the Director of Education.

5 Academic Representation Publicity

The members had a discussion around the academic representation publicity strategy. All members agree on the strategy with the aim to increase awareness of the academic representation system throughout the University.

6 AOCB

The School President of Economics & Finance asked the committee about School-specific extension polices.

Members discussed the roles of the Careers Advisor and the Careers Centre following concerns raised from the School President of IR.

The Director of Education asked members to report back on good practice within their Schools on

easing the transition Honours.
