What you will be doing:

- Be an active member of the Equal Opportunities Committee

How you will be doing it:

- Liaise with Student Services, the Careers Centre, the Director of Representation, and other Association elected officers
- Liaise with the access team who are in charge of lifelong and flexible learning
- Attend SRC and Equal Opportunities meetings

Useful skills or characteristics

- Have a knowledge understanding of the issues that face mature students while studying at university
- Be adaptable and communicative
- Have outreach with the mature student body
- Be able to work as part of a team
- Have good organisational skills

Skills you can expect to learn/develop

- Develop your confidence, communication and liaison skills
- Gain experience organising events
- Get experience of being a part of a diverse team (Equal Opportunities Committee) and working towards a common goal

On average you will spend 5-10 hours a week on this role, depending on meetings and events.
